The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 cfs.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 5, 2018, at Special Order Volume 107, Page 1027, approving Transfer Application T-12665, and together with Certificate 93720, supersedes Certificate 74460, State record of Water Right Certificates.
