CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-11021. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: ONE WELL, IN THE MULHOLLAND SLOUGH BASIN

USE: IRRIGATION OF 141.9 ACRES

RATE: 1.77 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: FEBRUARY 5, 1990

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

3 S	38 E	WM	12	SW SW	RUDD 2 - 200 FEET NORTH AND 1310 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, (or its equivalent) 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Rudd 2) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Rudd 1) described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


The right is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The water user shall be limited when it interferes with the prior SURFACE AND GROUND WATER rights of others.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 2, 2020, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 713, approving Transfer Application T- 13024, supersedes Certificate 68271, State record of Water Right Certificates.
