confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, another suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order at each new point of diversion, with the exception that water rights issued to the Bureau of Reclamation, or an irrigation district (or similar entity) are not subject to the condition.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards


The right to use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2021, at Special Order Volume 120, Page 467, approving Transfer Application T-13483, and together with Certificate 95258, supersedes Certificate T-16317, State record of Water Right Certificates.
