CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GUY KRISZA
299 SIDE RD 5
PAISLEY ONTARIO NOG2NO

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, tributary of MCKAY CREEK for IRRIGATION of 1.0 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8969. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.0125 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation described as follows:

2 N	32 E	WM	34	SE NE	2300 FEET SOUTH AND 870 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 34


When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 94797, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 26 2024, approving Transfer Application T-14429.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
