CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary the COLUMBIA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 327.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-48116. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.43 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acres, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, providing further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitations allowed herein, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation in part the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the groundwater supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the groundwater supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
