The specific limits for the use are listed below along with the conditions of use.

SOURCE OF WATER: ROCK CREEK, TRIBUTARY TO POWDER RIVER

BENEFICIAL USE: INSTREAM USE

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 11, 1902

ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE: 4120, for Power Claim 47.

To be maintained in: Township 8 South, Range 38 East, Section 5 SW 1/4 SW 1/4

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statute 543A.305 and Oregon Administrative Rule 690-054.


The following conditions apply to the use of the water under this certificate:

1. The right is limited to not more than 13 cubic feet per second as measured at the former point of diversion located in Township 8 South, Range 38 East, Section 5 SW 1/4 SW 1/4.
2. Authorized water uses, upstream of this right, by other existing water rights as of October 23, 1999, shall not be subject to regulation under Chapter 690, Division 250 to satisfy this instream water right.
3. The water right holder shall measure and report the instream flow at the point of the stream or river described in the certificate as may be required by the standards for instream water right reporting of the Water Resources Commission.
4. For purposes of water distribution, this instream right shall not have priority over waters legally stored or legally released from storage.

5. The instream flow allocated pursuant to this water right is not in addition to other instream flows created by a prior water right or designated minimum perennial stream flow.
