confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-8577. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: A SUMP WELL IN THE ALTHOUSE CREEK BASIN

USE: IRRIGATION OF 32.8 ACRES

RATE: 0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: MARCH 15, 1979

The sump well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The rights allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and shall further be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:


- a) The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, other suitable measuring device, as approved by the director, at each point of appropriation.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 26, 2016, at Special Order Volume 98, Page 663, approving Transfer Application T-11715, supersedes Certificate 60710, State record of Water Right Certificates.
