CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GILBERT CROWSON
PO BOX 275
CHRISTMAS VALLEY, OR 97641

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, tributary of FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 0.6 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9312. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 24, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 53452, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 16 2025, approving Transfer Application T-13973.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
