confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9407. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN THE MALHEUR LAKE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 72.7 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.91 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 19, 1981

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (Well 6), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well 1).

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a compete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Water measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where any meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 10, 2019, at Special Order Volume 113, Page 1093, approving Transfer Application T-12377, supercedes Certificate 82608, State record of Water Right Certificates.
