confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 38.2 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1887.

The right is limited to not more than 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (sump) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available for this right at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 7, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 355, approving Transfer Application T-7145, and supersedes Certificate 57368, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
