confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-46304. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: APPLGATE RIVER AND APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, TRIBUTARIES OF ROGUE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 7.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 48.6 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM STREAM AND 42.0 ACRE FEET FROM RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversions from the source.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 29, 1981

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 1-07-10-W0285, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (sump) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available for this right at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 7, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 355, approving Transfer Application T-7145, and Certificate 58913, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
