CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-8849. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: POA WITHIN THE FORT ROCK BASIN

USE: IRRIGATION OF 6.96 ACRES

RATE: 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: FEBRUARY 27, 1980

The well is located as follows:

25 S	15 E	WM	33	SW NE	POA 3 - 1120 FEET NORTH AND 1350 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 33

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (POA 3) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well 2) described as follows:

27 S	15 E	WM	3	NE NW	WELL 2 - SOUTH 63 DEGREES 40 MINUTES 1 SECOND EAST, 2923 FEET FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 3

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 9, 2022, at Special Order Volume 122, Page 477, approving Transfer Application T-13246, and together with Certificate 96050, supersedes Certificate 88683, State record of Water Right Certificates.
