confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-13739. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

## Measurement use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or, other measuring device, as approved by the director, in good working order, at each new point of appropriation, shall keep a record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Furter, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the right.
- b) The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired form the same aquifer (water source) at the original point of appropriation.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this right, then use of the water from the well shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interference.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the wall at all times.

The Director may require water level of pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 18, 2017, at Special Order Volume 104, Page 994, approving Transfer Application T-12493 supersedes Certificate 87310, State record of Water Right Certificates.
