The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 9, at Page 362.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The total quantity of water which may be diverted, during the irrigation season of each year, for the use shall not exceed 6.0 acre-feet, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (POD 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion (POD 1) described as follows:

13 S	9 E	WM	16	SW SW	POD 1 – 7 FEET NORTH AND 2338 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 16

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plan of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the weir or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each new point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where any meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain the headgate, to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.


The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 5, 2019, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 368, approving Transfer Application T-12370, supercedes Certificate 86411, State record of Water Right Certificates.
