The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 cfs at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 cfs at Oregon-Washington border.
