CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-3458. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

USE: IRRIGATION OF 63.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 88.9 ACRES

RATE: 1.86 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), FURTHER LIMITED TO 1.86 CFS FROM ORIGINAL WELL AND 1.11 CFS FROM ADDITIONAL WELL, NOT TO EXCEED 1.86 CFS IN ANY COMBINATION.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain an instantaneous read flow meter with totalizer, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 17, 2015, at Special Order Volume 96, Page 802, approving Transfer Application T-11747, and together with Certificate 90701, supersedes Certificate 43898, State record of Water Right Certificates.
