CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FESSLER FAMILY LLC  
 13009 MCKEE SCHOOL RD  
 WOODBURN, OR 97071

confirms the right to use the waters of ZOLLNER CREEK, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER for IRRIGATION on 11.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-25354. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 24, 1958.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen at the points of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 96727, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 06 2023, approving Transfer Application T-14141.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
