confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-8846. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL WITHIN DEEP CANYON BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 3.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 4, 1980

The well is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
14 S	11 E	WM	32	SE NE	274 FEET NORTH AND 191 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at the new point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where any meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain an in-flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 29, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 553, approving Transfer Application T-11782, and together with Certificate 89498, supercedes Certificate 88783, State record of Water Right Certificates.
