confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County, in the name of Pioneer Irrigation Company, tabulated in the names of C.J. Ward and G.J. Newman. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127 and in Volume 16, page 457

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITION POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 3, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1183, approving Transfer Application T-7766, and together with Certificate 75145, supersedes Certificate 75154, that portion of the Decree recorded in the order record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, Page 127, and in Volume 16, Page 457.
