 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

confirms the right to use the waters of CLACKAMAS RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER for the purpose of FISH HATCHERY.

This right was confirmed under Permit S-42105. The date of priority is AUGUST 4, 1977. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 45.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall operate and maintain fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW stands, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 18, 2016, at Special Order Volume 101, Page 425, approving Transfer Application T-12160, supersedes Certificate 53427, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
