CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM P. and GEORGE H. ANGELI  
222 LELAND RD  
SUNNY VALLEY, OR 97478

confirms the right to use the waters of SALMON CREEK and RESERVOIR constructed under Appl. No. R-41675, Permit Number R-4702, a tributary of GRAVE CREEK, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-31188. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 10, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4702, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to the use of stored water only on land described as supplemental and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 39786, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 27 2025, approving Transfer Application T-14065.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
