confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-35992. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: FIFTEEN MILE CREEK A TRIBUTARY OF COLUMBIA RIVER

USE: IRRIGATION OF 8.5 ACRES

RATE: 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: FEBRUARY 25, 1971

**The points of diversion are located as follows:**

2 S	12 E	WM	11	SW SE	(ORIGINAL) - 100 FEET NORTH AND 1380 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 11
2 S	12 E	WM	12	NE NW	(ADDITIONAL) - 1025 FEET SOUTH AND 2030 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

Water use measurement conditions:


- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the director in good working order at the new point of diversion.
- b) The water users shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered august 17, 2015, at Special Order Volume 96, Page 807, approving Transfer Application T-11775, supersedes Certificate 47329, State record of Water Right Certificates.
