CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-9595. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL, A TRIBUTARY TO APPLIGATE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 3.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 15, 1930

The well is located as follows:

37 S	6 W	WM	25	NE SE	90 FEET NORTH AND 585 FEET WEST FROM E-S1/16 CORNER, SECTION 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The well from which the water is taken under this right shall be constructed so that the use of the well will affect the surface water source similarly to the use of the original authorized point of diversion.

The well from which this water is taken under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of diversion/appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where any meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change FROM SURFACE WATER POINT OF DIVERSION TO A GROUNDWATER POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 2, 2019, at Special Order Volume 112, Page 225, approving Transfer Application T-12669, and together with Certificate 94067, supercedes Certificate 10869, State record of Water Right Certificates.
