confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-51265. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: LITTLE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF NORTH UMPQUA RIVER

PURPOSE or USE: IRRIGATION OF 5.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE FAMILY

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.069 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.064 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC

PERIOD OF USE: WATER MAY ONLY BE APPROPRIATED FOR IRRIGATION DURING THE PERIOD MARCH 1 THROUGH JUNE 30

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 6, 1991

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be maintained and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
