CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EIGHTMILE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY TO FIFTEENMILE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 17.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 406. The date of priority is 1891.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE IN ANY IRRIGATION SEASON.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen at the new point of diversion.

The said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use water for purposes aforesaid is restricted to lands or place of use herein described.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 20, 2005, at Special Order Volume 65, Page 463, approving Transfer Application T- 9815, supercedes Certificate 32604, State record of Water Right Certificates.
