confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9170. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: THREE WELLS IN THE FORT ROCK BASIN

USE: IRRIGATING 37.3 ACRES

RATE: 0.46 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.43 CFS FROM WELL 1, 0.03 CFS FROM WELL 2, AND 0.46 CFS FROM WELL 8, OR IN ANY COMBINATION NOT TOTALING MORE THAN 0.46 CFS.

PRIORITY DATE: JANUARY 12, 1981

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 26, 2009, at Special Order Volume 77, Page 148, approving Transfer Application T-9420, supersedes Certificate 67907, State record of Water Right Certificates.
