confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9490. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: G-9275

SOURCE OF WATER: A SUMP IN DAVIS CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: FLOOD HARVEST OF CRANBERRIES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.52 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: JUNE 12, 1979

The sump is located as follows:

The amount of water used shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
