confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-49. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 112 ACRES

RATE: 1.40 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: AUGUST 3, 1955

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

If the basin-fill sediments are fully penetrated during the drilling of the proposed well, thus tapping the underlying bedrock units within the basin, the portion of the well bore below this interface must be properly abandoned with cement grout, in order to maintain an open interval within the basin-fill sediments from which the existing POA currently pumps ground water.

The water user shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID Tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well, The well ID Shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

Water use measurement conditions:


- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each new point of appropriation.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device(s); provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the land or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 15, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 773, approving Transfer Application T-11896, supersedes Certificate 28634, State record of Water Right Certificates.
