confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 31, at Page 258.

USE: IRRIGATION OF 171.5 ACRES, OF LAND, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE

THE RATE OF FLOW: 4.29 SEC. FEET. FROM APRIL 1ST TO MAY 1ST AND 2.15 SEC. FEET FROM MAY 1ST TO SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> OF EACH YEAR, OF THE EQUIVALENT IN CASE OF ROTATION; THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED DURING EACH IRRIGATION SEASON NOT TO EXCEED 514.5 ACRE FEET.

PRIORITY DATE: 1880 FOR 156.5 ACRES AND 1885 FOR 15.0 ACRES

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversions, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of diversion.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each point of diversion new and existing, in good working order.
- b) The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters and measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


The water user shall the maintain a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational ad maintenance standards.

The right to use of the water aforesaid herby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 24, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 761, approving Transfer Application T-11585, supersedes Certificate 1582, State record of Water Right Certificates.
