CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit U-367. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: THREE WELLS WITHIN THE MILL BOULDER CREEK BASIN

USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 263.7 ACRES

RATE: 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: AUGUST 18, 1950

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and, shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new and additional points of appropriation and diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation and diversions, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation and diversion.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each point of appropriation new and existing in, good working order.
- b) The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters and measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


The water user shall maintain the headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 24, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 761, approving Transfer Application T-11585, supersedes Certificate 22866, State record of Water Right Certificates.
