The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new and additional points of appropriation and diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation and diversions, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation and diversion

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each point of appropriation new and existing, in good working order.
- b) The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters and measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain the headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted, as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate a fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational ad maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION AND A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 24, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 761, approving Transfer Application T-11585, supersedes Certificate 46075, State record of Water Right Certificates.
