CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICK A. HUFSTADER AND CYNTHIA STRICKLAND

NAUKATI, AK 99950

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 7.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-18828. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.1775 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed FIVE ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order at the new point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


The water user shall operate and maintain an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 90320, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 29 2024, approving Transfer Application T-14103.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
