**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall equip and maintain all wells (being the authorized and new points of appropriation) with an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described; however water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.570(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 11, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Page 33, approving Transfer Application T-8536, supersedes Certificate 37291, State record of Water Right Certificates.
