CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES AND ETHEL SPIKER  
RT 3 BOX 166  
SCIO, OR 97374

confirms the right to use the waters of CRABTREE CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 1.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-32518. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 43483, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 29 2025, approving Transfer Application T-14211.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place if use here described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
