CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

B. L. DAVIS RANCH, INC.
ROUTE 1
ADAMS, OR 97810

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, a tributary of WILDHORSE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 1.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4371. The date of priority is OCTOBER 16, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
3 N	34 E	WM	4	SW NW	30 FEET NORTH AND 70 FEET EAST FROM THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 40919, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 27 2024, approving Transfer Application T-14267.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
