The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, (Well #1), combined with that at the original point of appropriation, (Well #2), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation (Well #2).

Water use measurements:

- a) The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter, or, other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 2, 2021, at Special Order Volume 118, Page 470, approving Transfer Application T-13355, supersedes Certificate 67582, State record of Water Right Certificates.
