CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ED THOMSON  
WALLOWA, OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER (aka SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER), a tributary of WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 31.21 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 197. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per are during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate together with Certificates 97431 and 97432 supersedes Certificate 3162, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
