CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROCKING M CATTLE COMPANY
70208 WARNOCK RD
WALLOWA, OR 97885

confirms the right to use the waters of the LOSTINE RIVER (aka SOUTH FORK WALLOWA RIVER), a tributary to the WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 72.29 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 5, at Page 197. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.99 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND and is limited to 1.0 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per are during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree, and is further limited to 180.73 Acre Feet per year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 3162, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 129, Page 305, approving conserved water application CW-129. This certificate together with Certificates 97430 and 97432 supersedes Certificate 3162, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 3162, and any related decree.
