confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-11106. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: TWO WELLS IN THE DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN

USE: IRRIGATION OF 0.56 ACRE

RATE: 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: JUNE 28, 1990

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The Department may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water right use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior right, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 19, 2005, at Special Order Volume 63, Page 106, approving Transfer Application T-7794, and together with Certificate 80994, supersedes Certificate 80653, State record of Water Right Certificates.
