CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF CENTRAL POINT 140 S 3RD STREET CENTRAL POINT OR 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH AND SOUTH FORKS LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, tributaries of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, said decree entered of record at Salem in the Order Record of the State Engineer in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 14, 1899. This right is limited to 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

The rate of diversion for municipal use under this right and Certificates 97453, 97454, and 97455 shall be limited to a maximum combined rate of diversion of 0.35 cubic foot per second and shall be further limited to a combined volume diverted of 51.8 acre feet during the time period of April 1 to October 1.

The water user shall maintain a suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

The right to use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained to said decree; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 29, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 275, approving Transfer Application T-10465, and together with Certificate 85286, supersedes Certificate 80566, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
