 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF CENTRAL POINT
 140 S 3RD STREET
 CENTRAL POINT OR 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH AND SOUTH FORKS LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, tributaries of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit E-19. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1909. This right is limited to 0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The rate of diversion for municipal use under this right and Certificates 97454, and 97455 shall be limited to a maximum combined rate of diversion of 0.50 cubic foot per second and shall be further limited to a combined volume diverted of 342.6 acre feet during the time period of April 1 to October 1.

Certificate 80569, together with certificate numbered 80570 for irrigation within the Medford Irrigation District, confirms all water rights perfected under Permit E-19. Total diversions through the Main Canal from North Fork and South Fork of Little Butte Creek shall not exceed 140 CFS at any one time, being 50 CFS for Rogue River Valley Irrigation District and 90 CFS for Medford Irrigation District. Total diversions from North Fork Little Butte Creek shall not exceed 125 CFS at any one time. Total diversions from South Fork Little Butte Creek shall not exceed 100 CFS at any one time.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.


The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 29, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 275, approving Transfer Application T-10465, and together with Certificate 85288, supersedes Certificate 80569, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
