 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF CENTRAL POINT
 140 S 3RD STREET
 CENTRAL POINT OR 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1888.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.059 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and 21.6 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water use shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion, being the diversion rate in cubic feet per second authorized for the right, further limited to the annual total volume of 21.6 acre feet, described as follows:

The right to use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 1, 2005, at Special Order Volume 67, Page 411, approving Transfer Application T-9900, supersedes Certificate 32742, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
