CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARTIN SCHNEIDER JR
RT 1 BOX 49
MT ANGEL OREGON 97362

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 29.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1402. The date of priority is JULY 14, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), provided the total appropriated under Permit G-1402 does not exceed 0.22 cfs, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 31135, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 6, 2009, at Special Order Volume 77, Page 339 diminishing a portion of the water right, and together with Certificate 97527, supersedes Certificate 31135, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
