CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK L. AND BETTY M. NIMS
21980 SW AEBISCHER ROAD
SHERWOOD, OR 97140

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION NO. R-38892, PERMIT NO. R-3420, tributary of CHICKEN CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 5.85 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28955. The date of priority is JULY 12, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 75881, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 22 2024, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water CW-131, recorded at Special Order Volume 129, Page 669. This certificate, together with Certificates 97564 and 97565 and the conserved water under CW-131, supersedes Certificate 75881, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
