CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the AN UNNAMED CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION NO. R-38892, PERMIT NO. R-3420, tributary of CHICKEN CREEK, for INSTREAM USE for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat, and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28955. The date of priority is JULY 12, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.011 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, from MAY 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, further limited to an annual volume of 4.0 ACRE-FEET.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is from the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 75881, as follows:

2S	2W	WM	26	SE SW	1090 FEET NORTH AND 340 FEET WEST FROM THE S1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26

To: the confluence with the unnamed stream in the SW SE of Section 26, T2S, R2W, WM.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.346, 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.


The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 75881, and any related decree.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 129, Page 669, approving Conserved Water Application CW-131. This Certificate together with Certificates 97563 and 97564, and the conserved water under CW-131 supersedes Certificate 75881, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
