confirms the right to use the waters of ZOLLNER CREEK, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.9 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-23108. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.011 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
