## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22718. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 20, 1953. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.25 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
