confirms the right to use the waters of BRONSON CREEK, a tributary of the CHEHALEM CREEK, to maintain an instream flow for public use.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 543A.305 based on the conversion of Hydroelectric License HE 451 to an instream water right.

The date of priority is April 8, 1977.

The right is expressly made inferior in right and subsequent in time to any appropriation of water from this source which may hereafter be made for domestic, municipal, irrigation, or any other beneficial consumptive use.

The right is limited to not more than 4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.


This right is for flows to be maintained in Bronson Creek at the site of the former point of diversion under HE 241 located within the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W.M., Yamhill County.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is a Final Order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period for specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080 you may petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied
