## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED SPRINGS, tributary to SANDY RIVER for COMMERCIAL USE.

The right was perfected under Permit S-26057. The date of priority is APRIL 7, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.225 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 88726, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered <a href="MAR">MAR</a> 1 3 2024 , approving Transfer Application T-14063.

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The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
