CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, to maintain an instream flow for public use.

The right is established under Oregon Laws 2010 Chapter 63, Oregon Revised Statutes 543A.305, and Oregon Administrative Rule 690-054 based on the conversion of Hydroelectric License HE 363 in the names of James B. and Janet A. Boyd to an instream water right.

The date of priority is OCTOBER 21, 1981.

The right is expressly made inferior in right and subsequent in time to any appropriation of water from this source which may be made for domestic, municipal, irrigation, or any other beneficial consumptive use.

The right is limited to not more than 500 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND and is limited to the season of DECEMBER 1 through JUNE 30 of each year.

This right is for flows to be maintained in the Umatilla River at the site of the former point of diversion under HE 363 located within the SE¼ SW ¼, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is a Final Order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period for specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080 you may petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This instream right is not additive to other instream water rights.

This Water Right Certificate supersedes Hydroelectric License HE 363.
